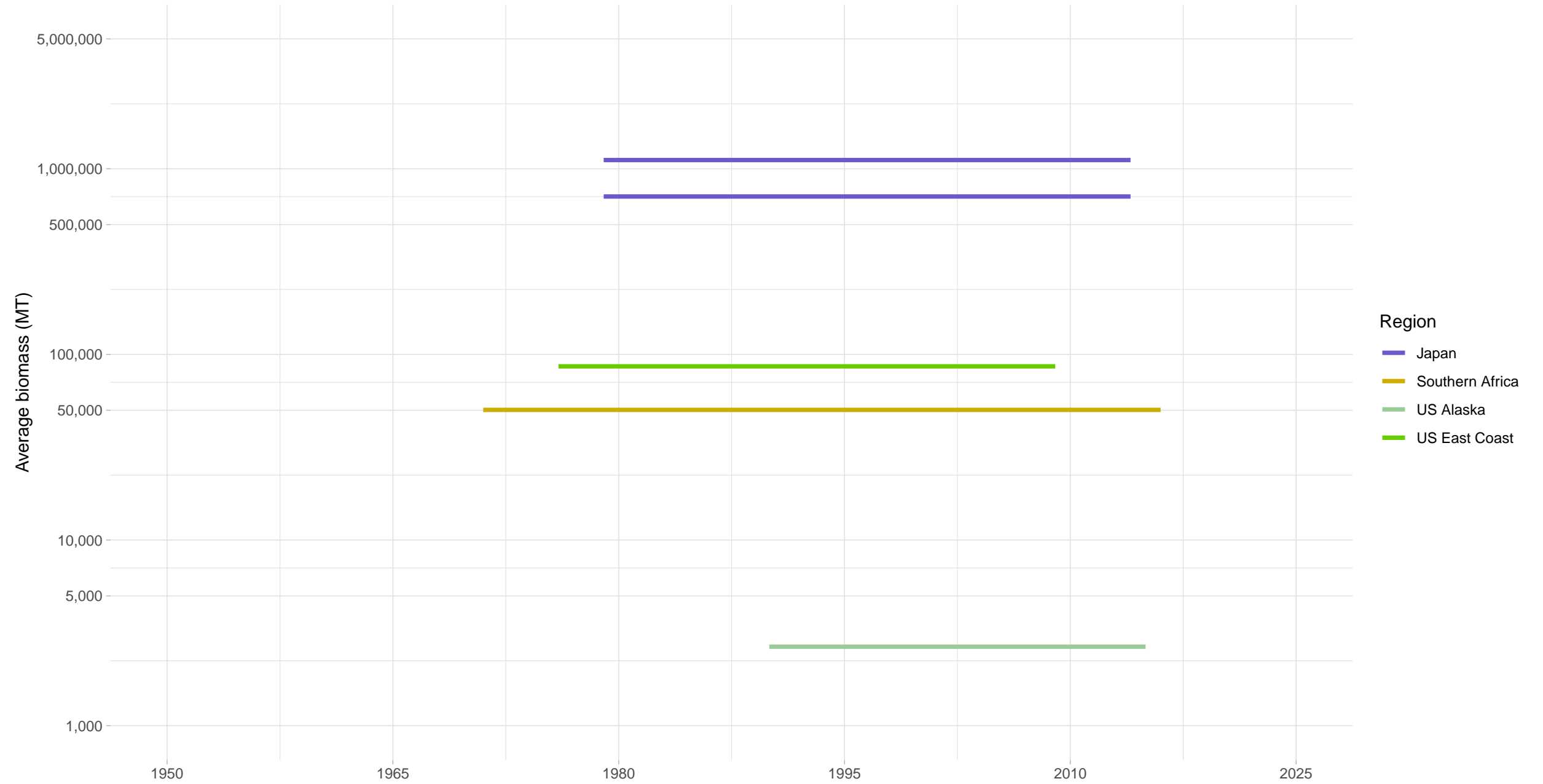
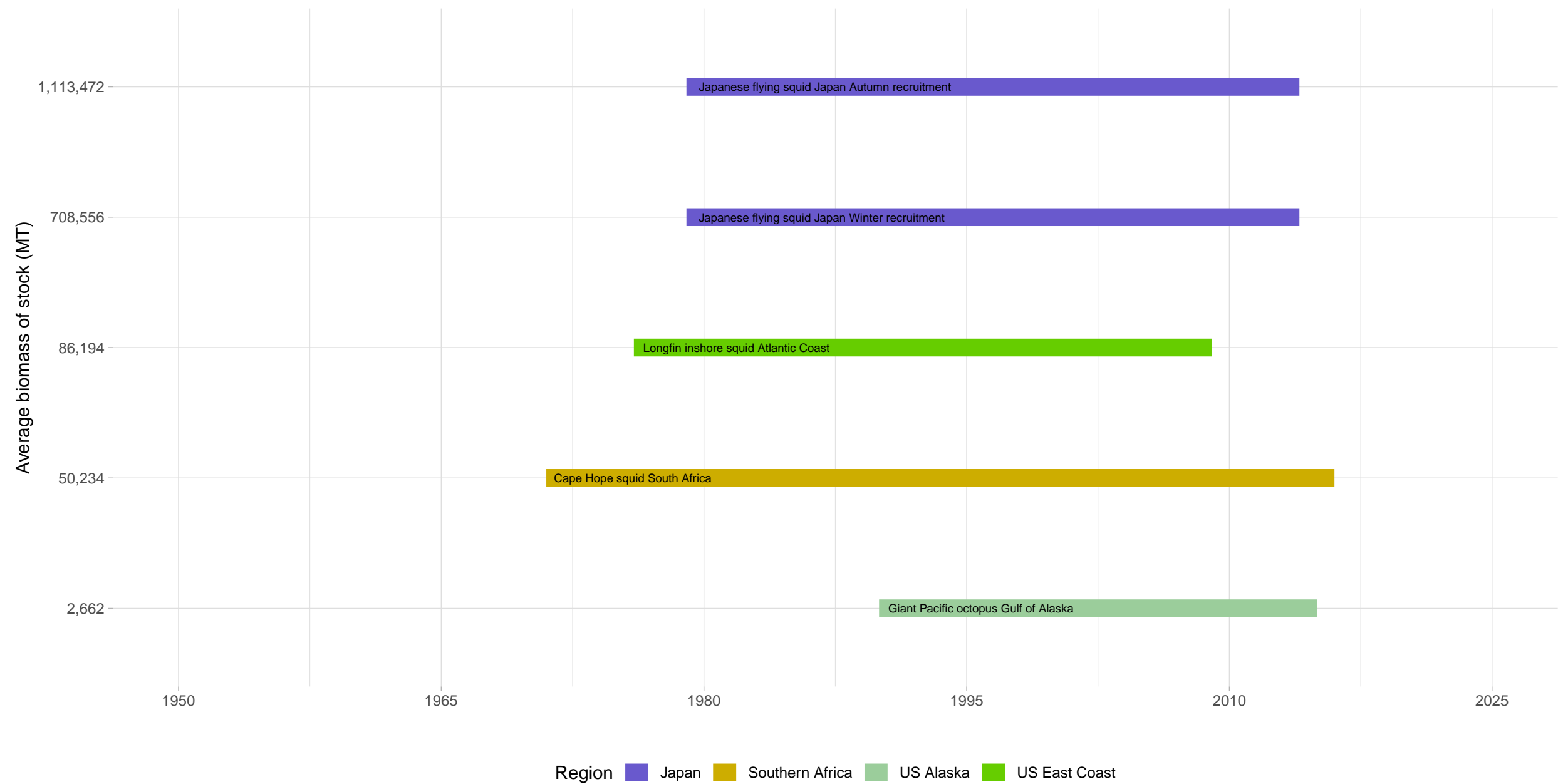


Biomass Coverage in Cephalopods Taxonomy Group



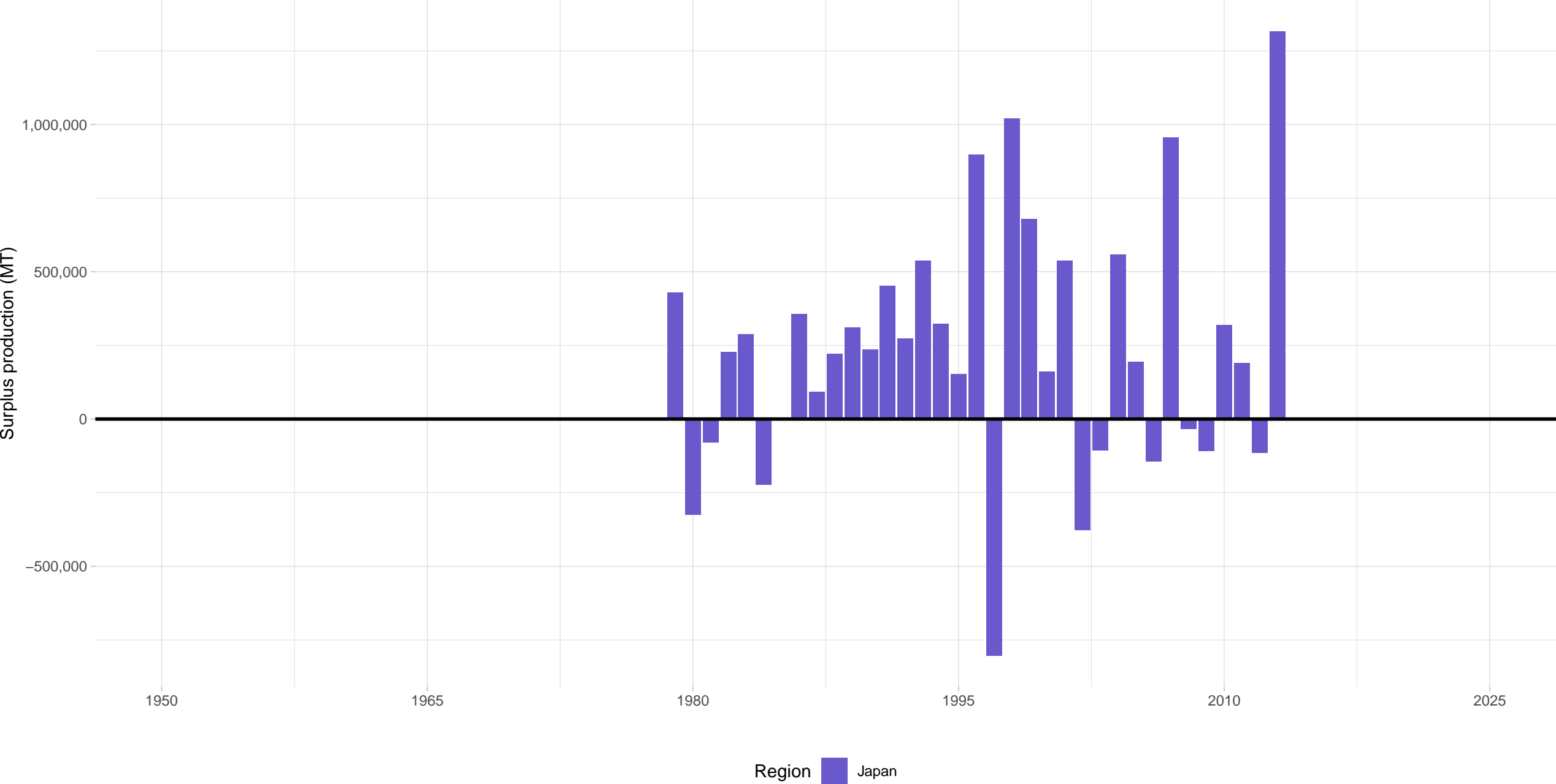
Biomass Coverage Over Time in Cephalopods Taxonomy Group

Stocks ordered from lowest to highest average biomass



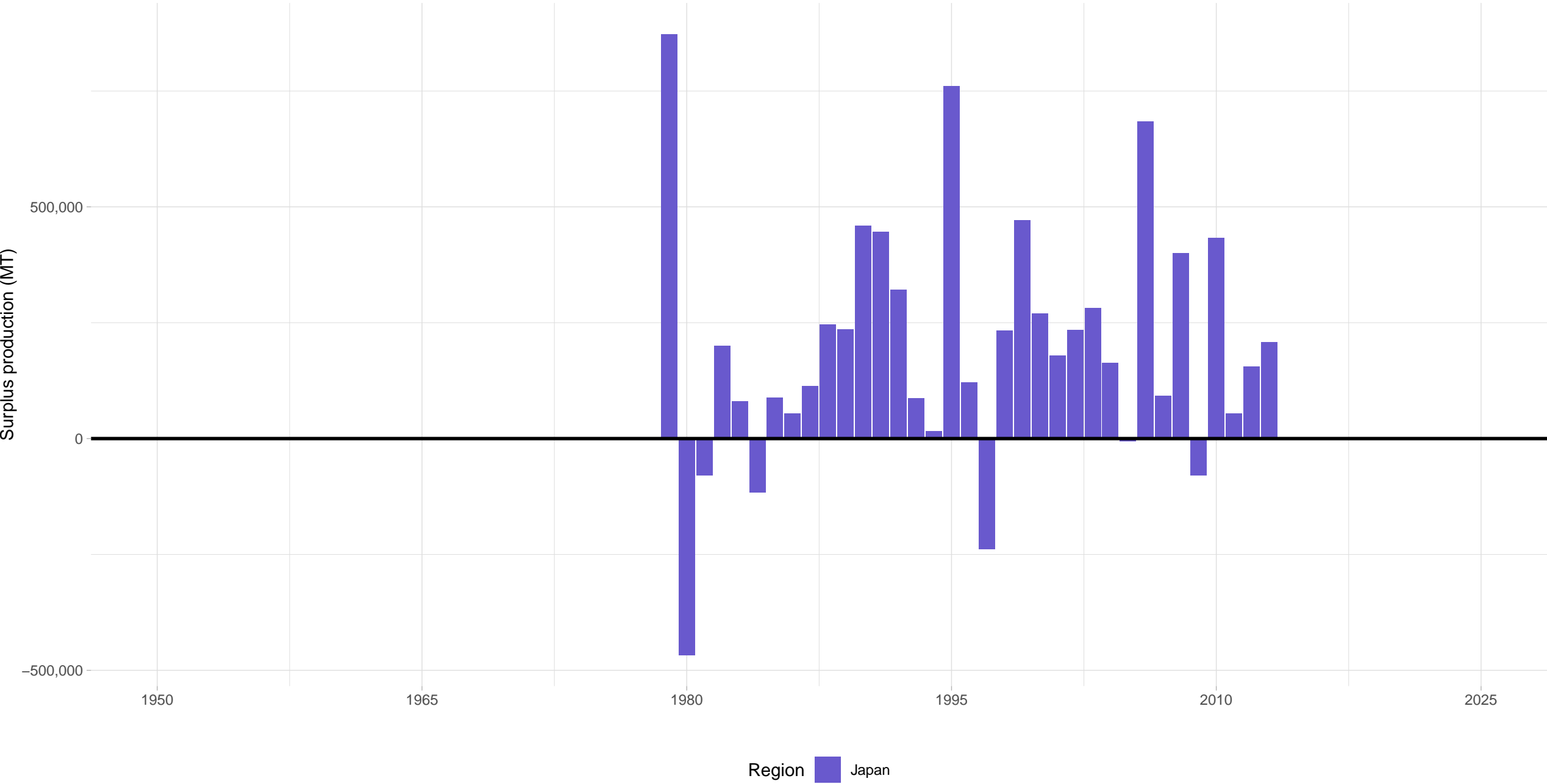
Japanese flying squid Japan Autumn recruitment – Cephalopods Taxonomy Group

Stock represents 55% of average absolute surplus production



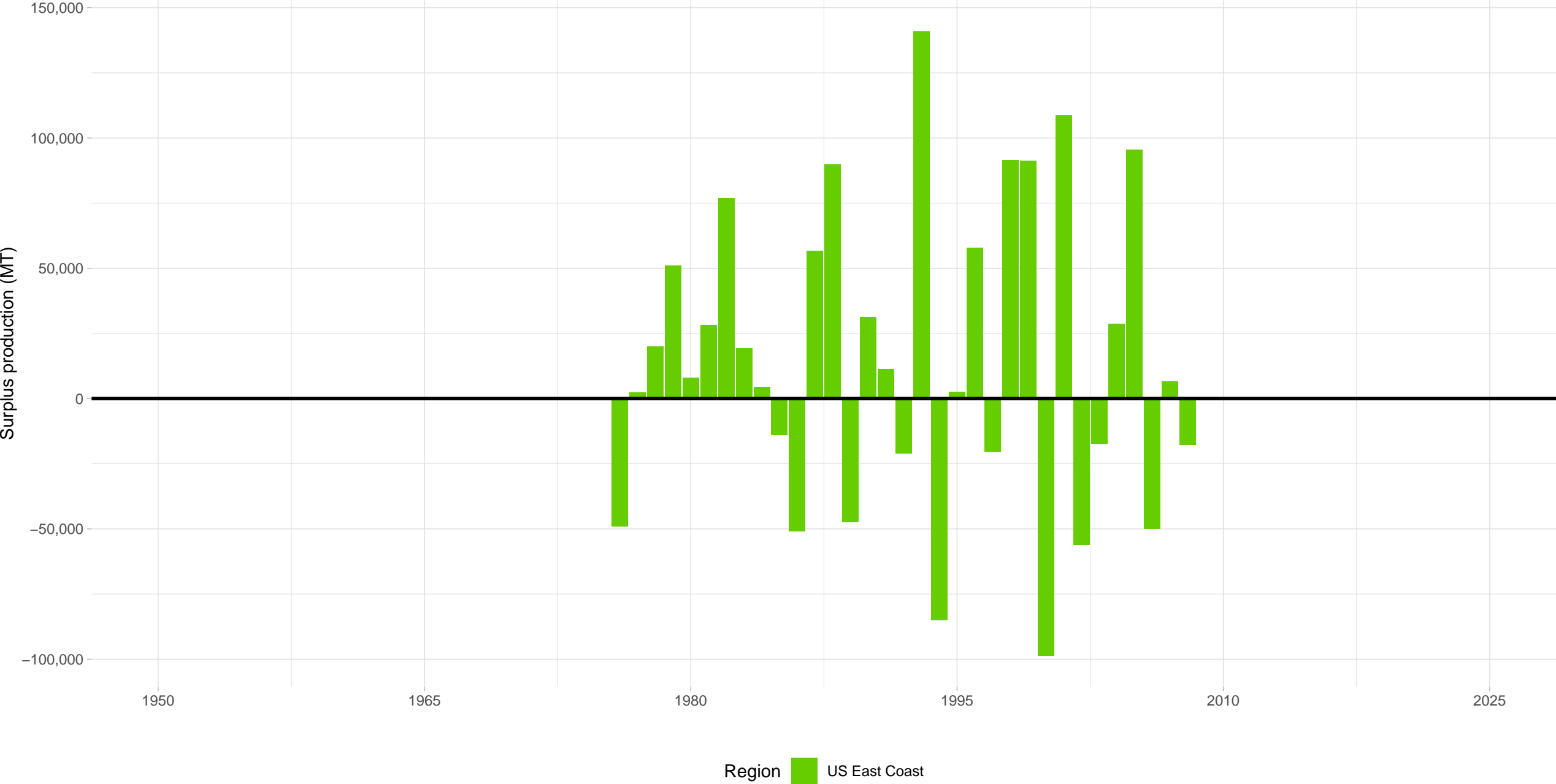
Japanese flying squid Japan Winter recruitment – Cephalopods Taxonomy Group

Stock represents 37% of average absolute surplus production



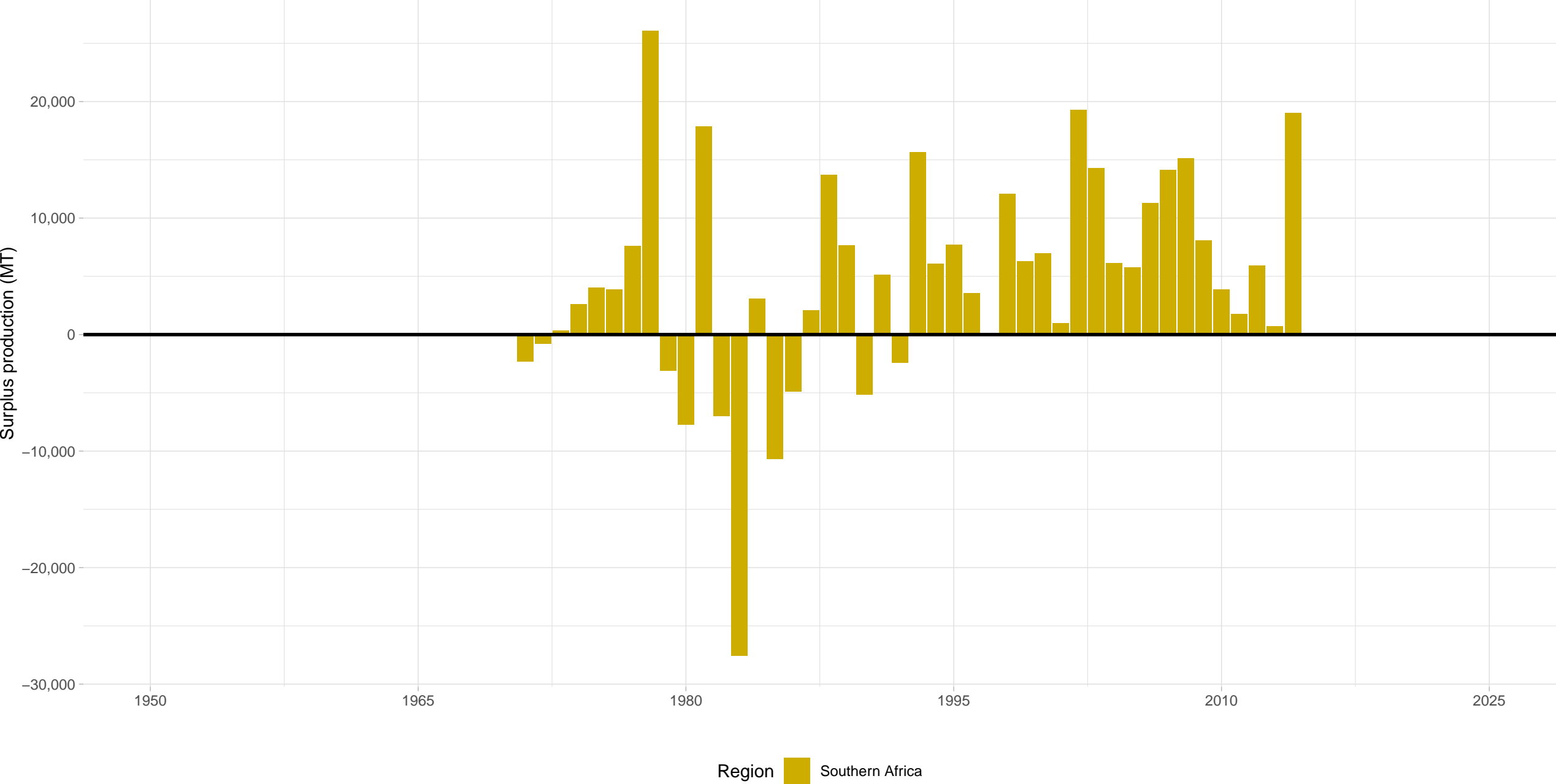
Longfin inshore squid Atlantic Coast – Cephalopods Taxonomy Group

Stock represents 7% of average absolute surplus production

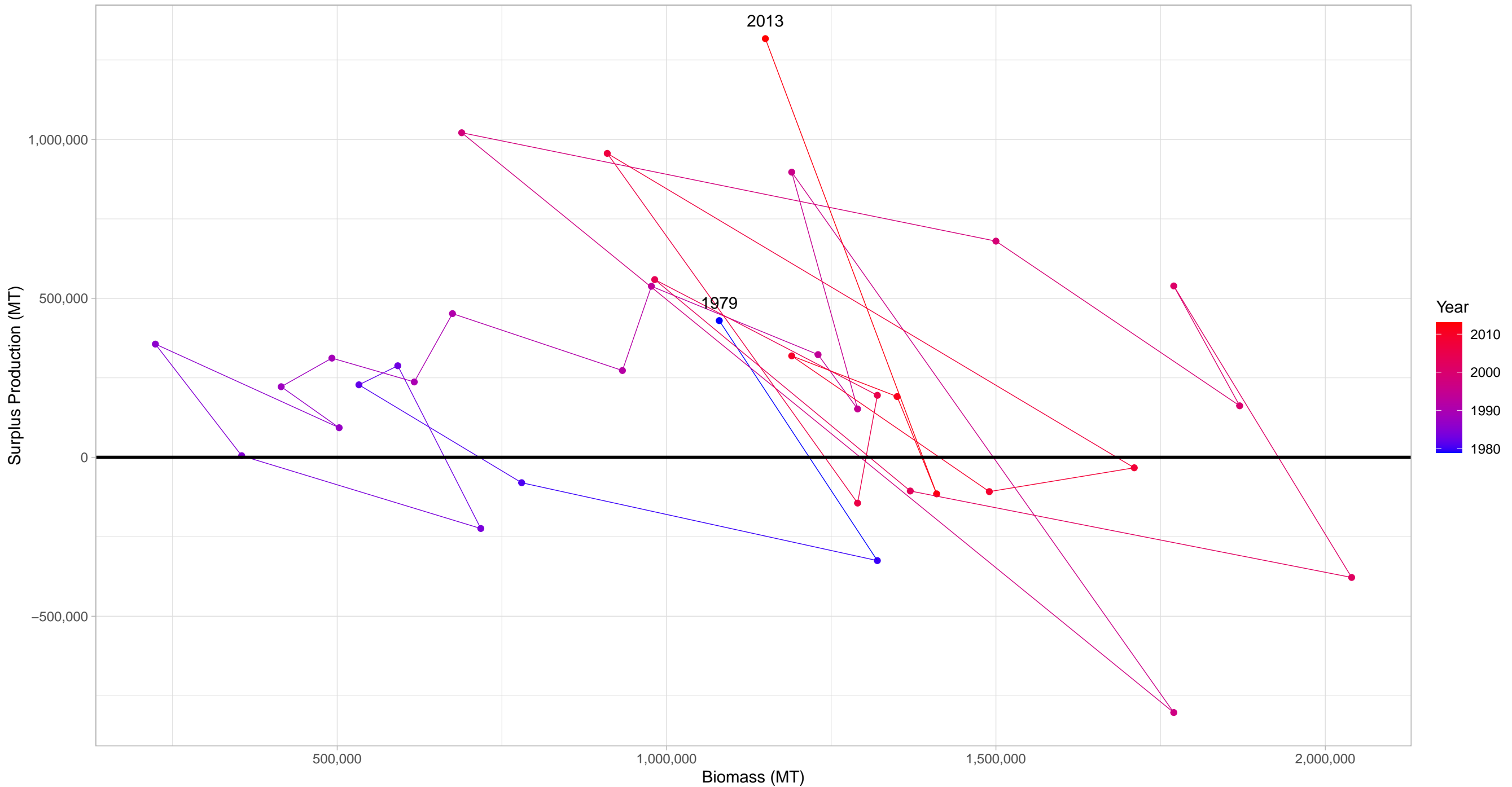


Cape Hope squid South Africa – Cephalopods Taxonomy Group

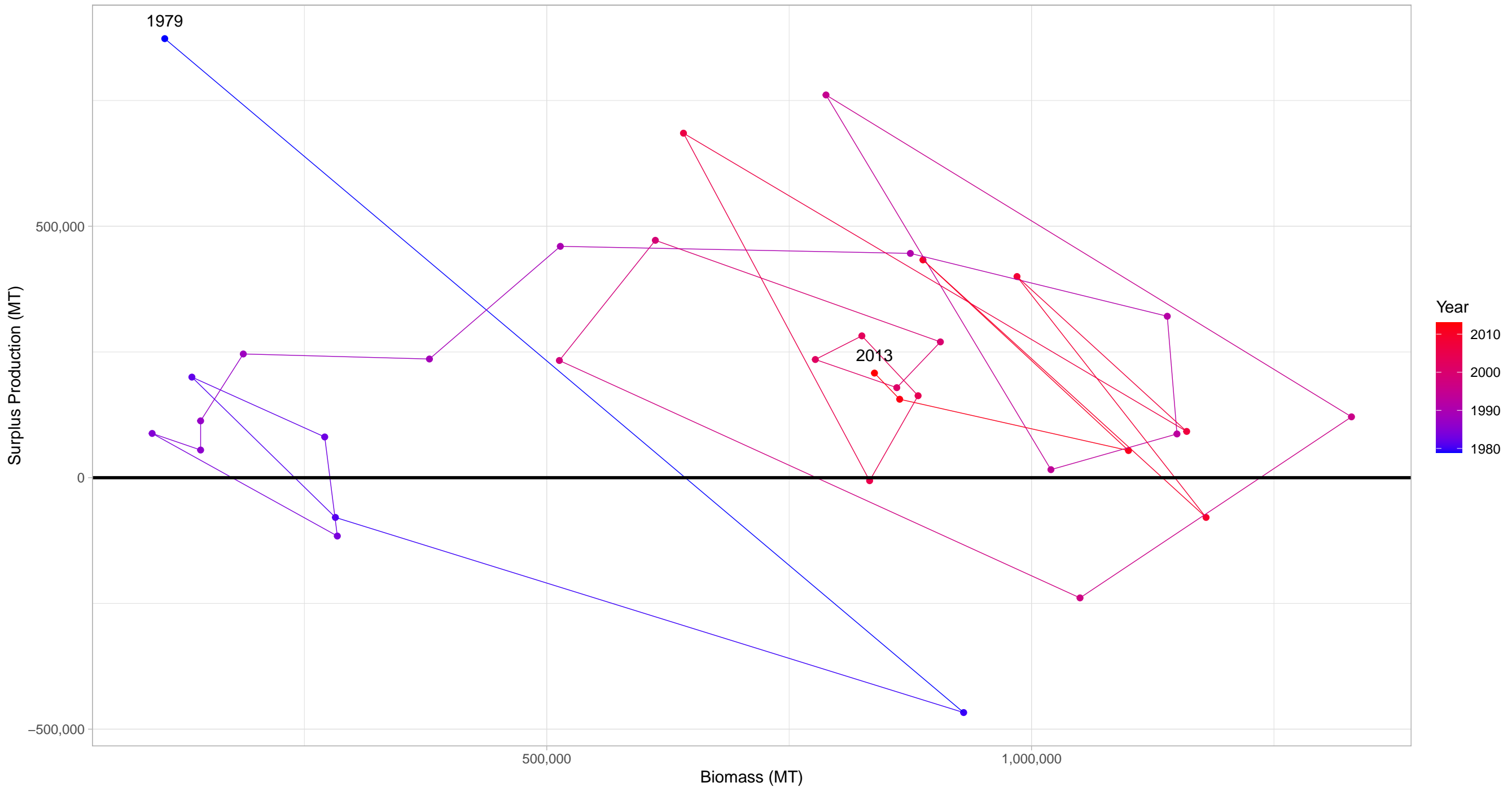

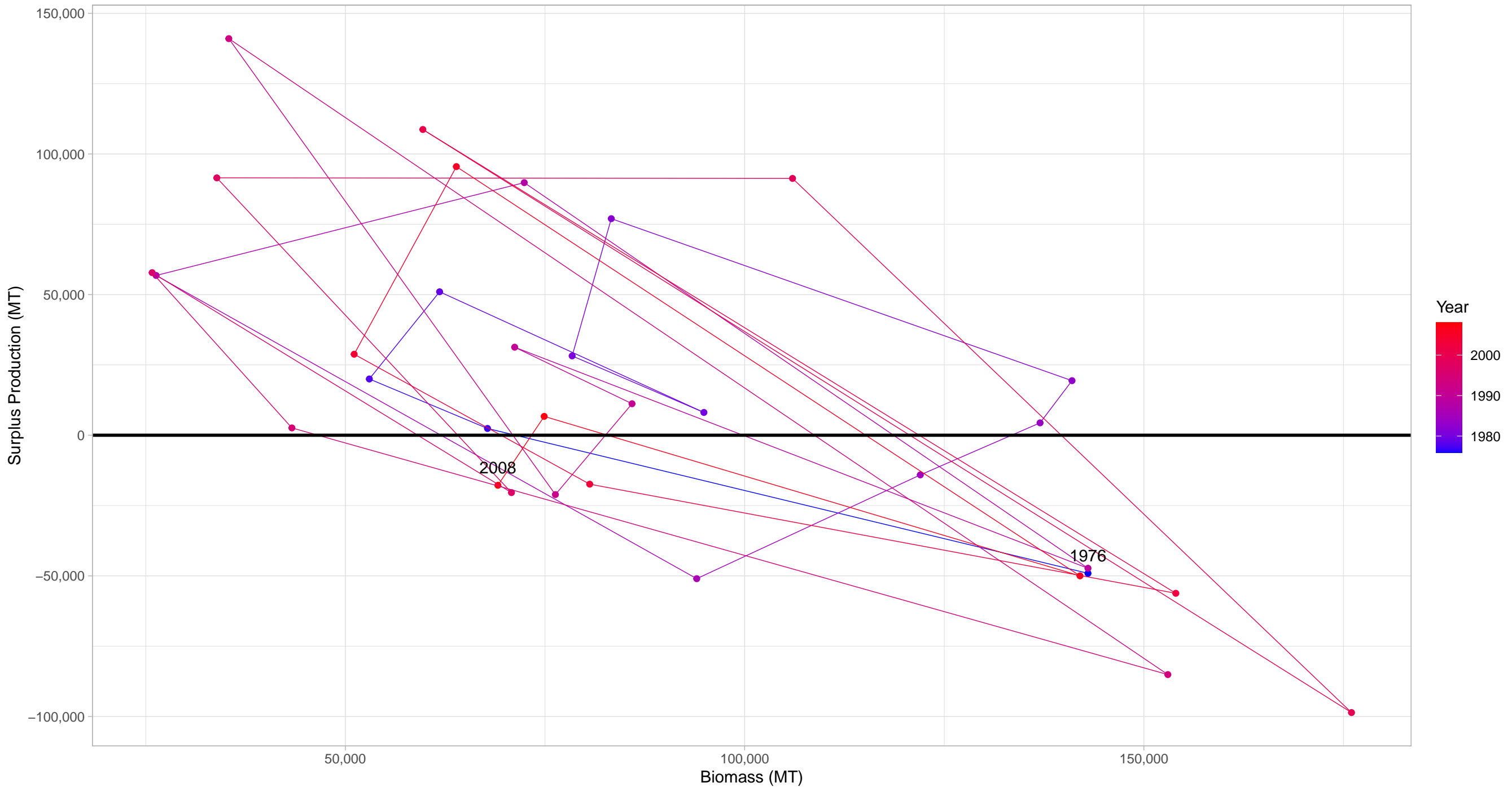


# Japanese flying squid Japan Winter recruitment in Cephalopods Taxonomy Group



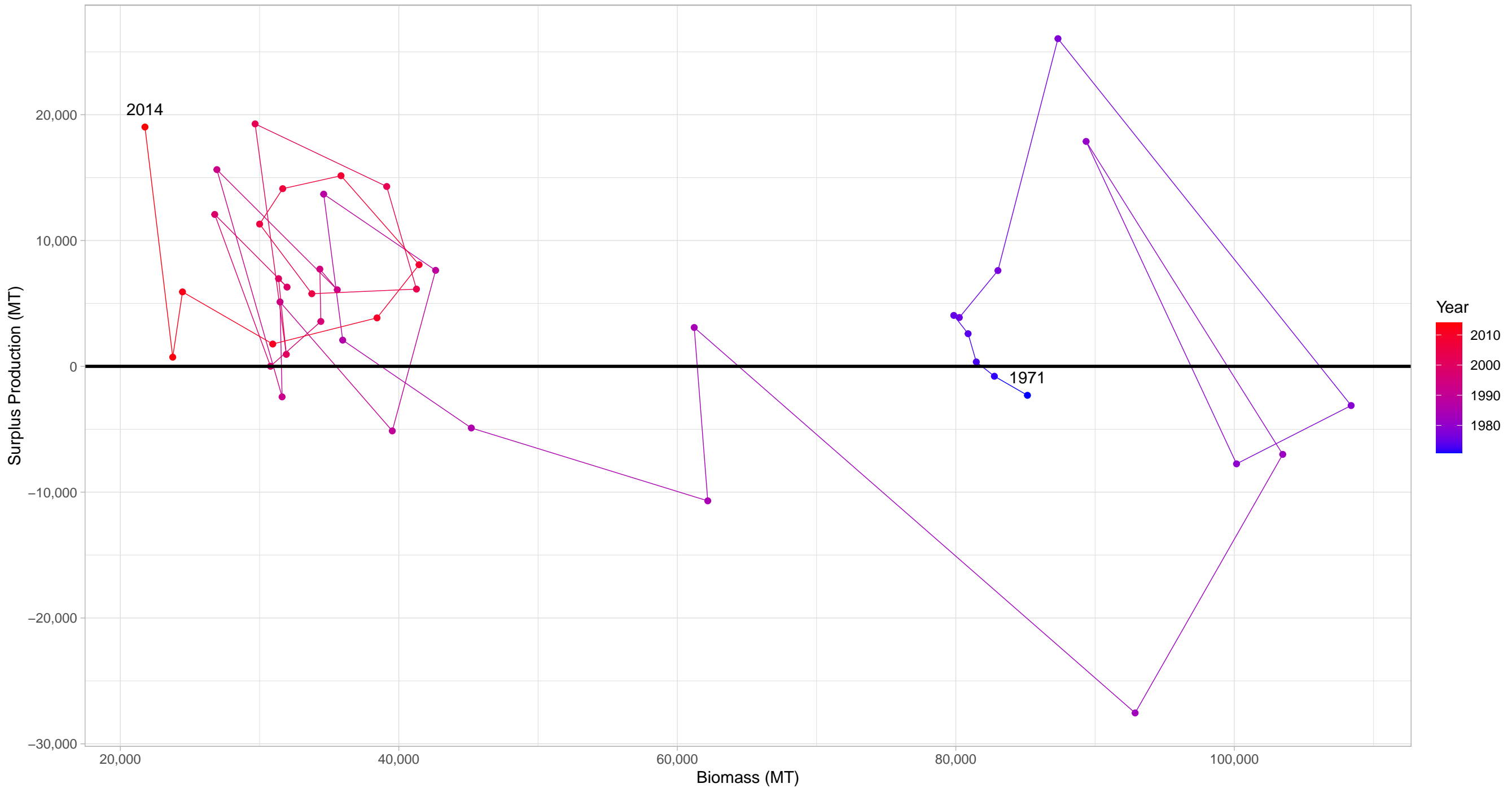


# Longfin inshore squid Atlantic Coast in Cephalopods Taxonomy Group
